

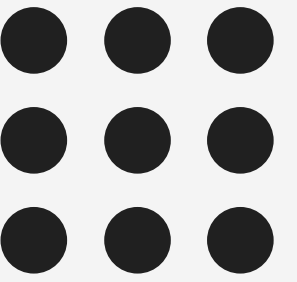

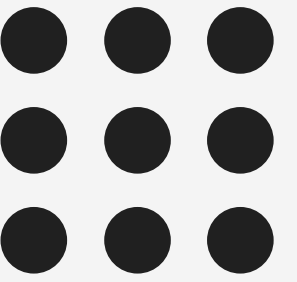

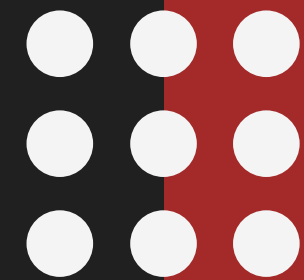
You will understand the importance of creating a relevant, realistic, recognizable, repeatable, and refreshing yearbook theme.
